North Carolina was the second state in the nation to enact a retail sales tax (in 1933) In 1933, the state levied a 3% state-level tax Increased to 4% in 1991 Temporary increase of 5% in 2001 Added a local-level tax of 1% in 1971 Increased by 5% in 1983 Increased by 5% in 1986 Increased by 5% in 2002
